12. Method of preparation	Clean all the herbal ingredients and took according to the formula. Soak in 4 times of water. Next day took distilled extract; to the distillate add honey, Saindhav, camphor and preservatives- Phenyl ethyl alcohol 0.05% and Benzalkonium chloride 0.02%. Using pressure vessel & membrane holder, Filter through pre filter 2micron filter paper and then 0.2µ micron filter paper to sterilize the solution and fill in desired container in sterilized area.				
13. Indications	Useful in eye flu, conjunctivitis, tiredness of eyes, redness and for healthy vision.				
14. Dosage	One to two drops in each eye three to four times a day.
